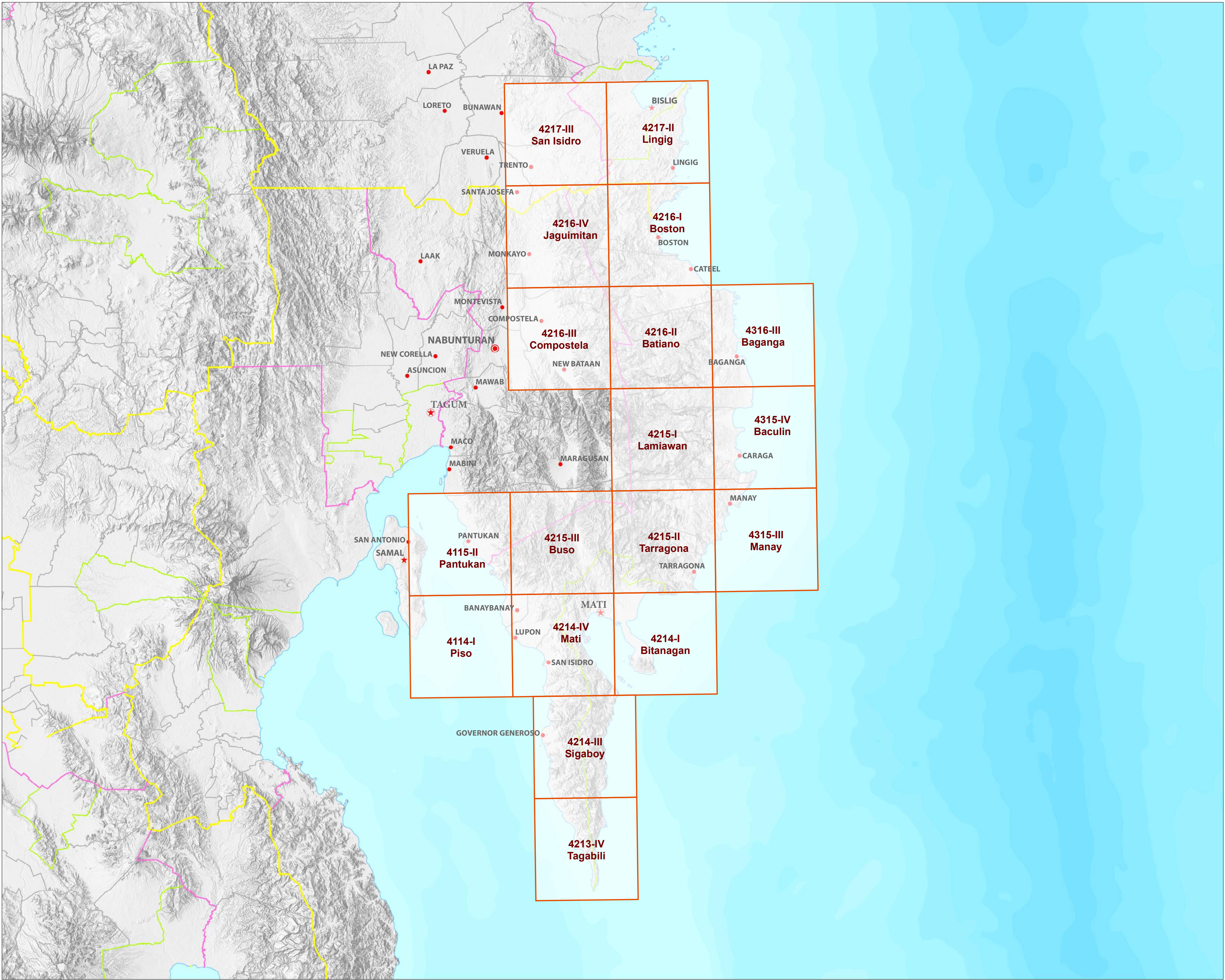

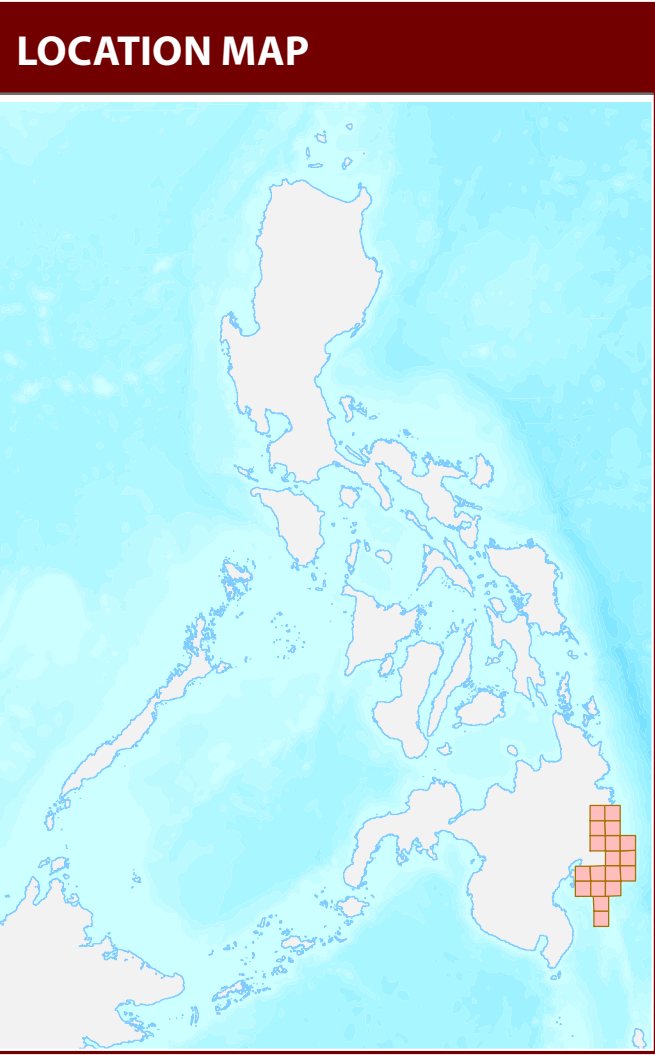

CLIMATE TYPE

TYPE I : Two pronounced season, dry from November to April and wet during the rest of the year. TYPE III : No very pronounced maximum rain period, with a dry season lasting only from one to three months, either during the period from December to February or from March to May. This type resembles Type I since it has a short dry season.	TYPE IV : Rainfall is more or less evenly distributed throughout the year. This type resembles Type II since it has no dry season.

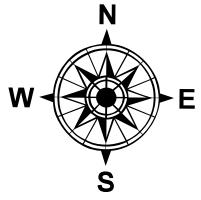

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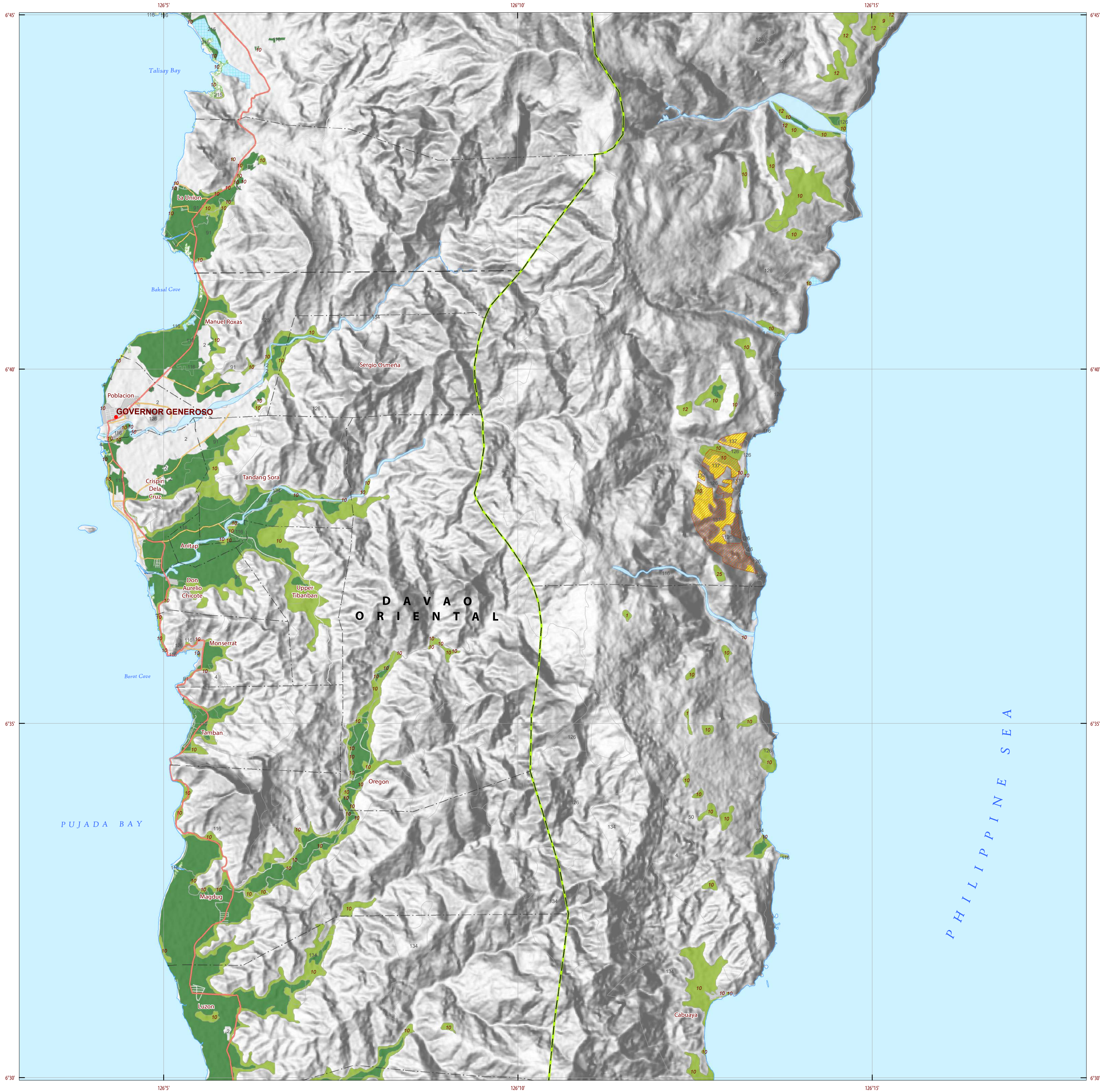
